


Amazon account setup instructions

Step 1: Logon to Amazon web service website, <http://aws.amazon.com/>

Step 2: Click on the 'Signup' button on the top right



Step 3: On the Signup page, If you are already using Amazon and want to use Amazon AWS, type your email id which you use for logging on to Amazon, select the option 'I am a returning user and my password is' button, and provide your Amazon password.

If you are a new user to Amazon, type your email id and select 'I am a new user'

Finally, Click on 'Sign in using our secure server' button






Step 9: You will be redirected to the registration confirmation page. On the top left, under 'My Account/ Console', select 'My Account'.
